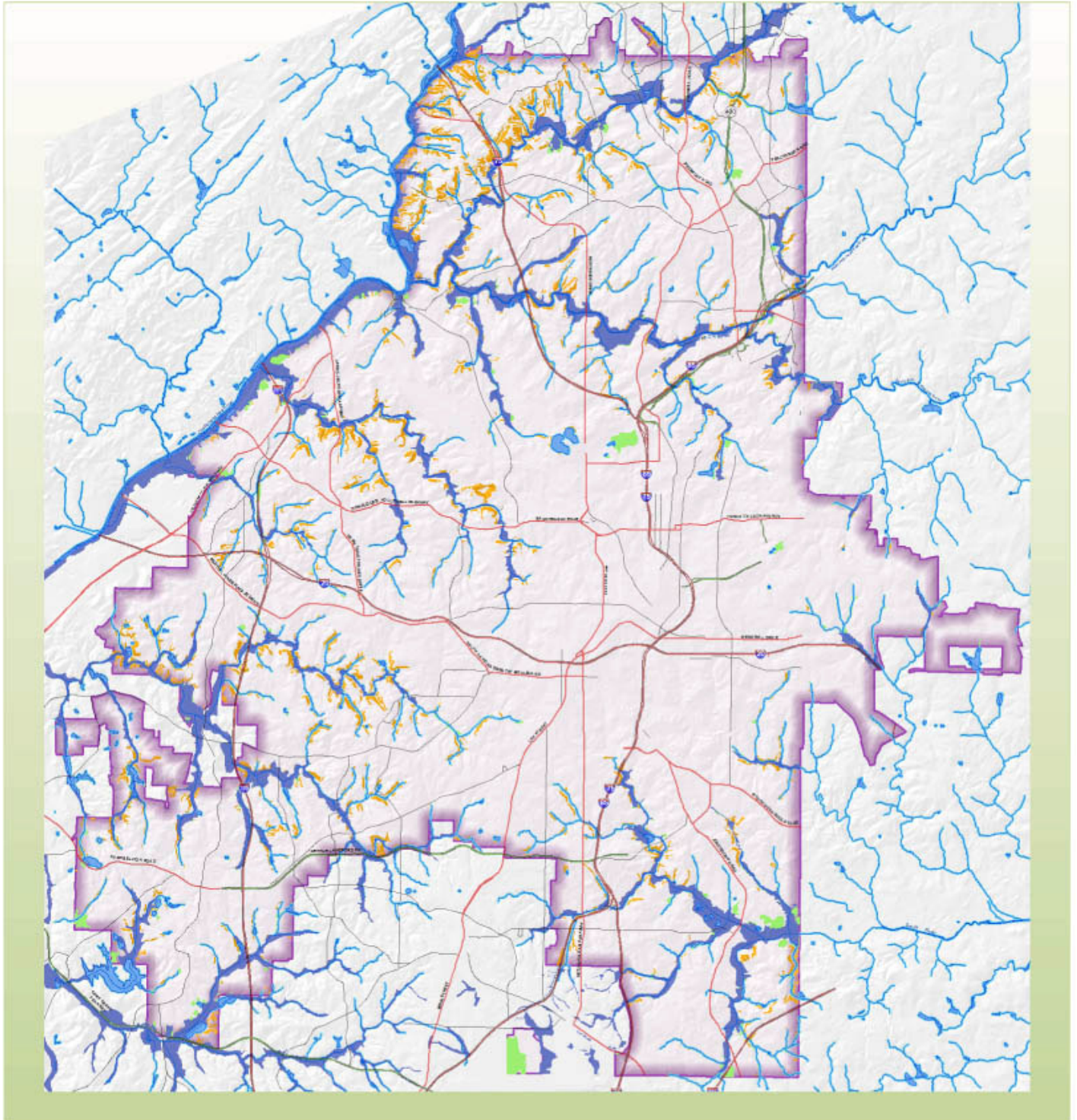




# Drainage System Framework

This map shows main features in the hydrologic drainage system of Atlanta, including waterways, flood plains, and steep areas where runoff and erosion directly impacts streams.

### Legend

-  100 year FEMA flood plain
-  Flat, potentially flood prone areas
-  Buffer zone, 75 ft. from streams and shorelines
-  Slopes > 20% draining directly to streams
